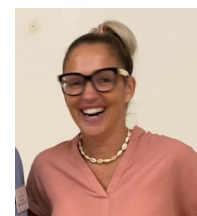

Visit to Worsley Old Hall and Canal Basin

On 13 June 14 of us visited Worsley Old Hall and then joined a fascinating guided walk around the Bridgewater Canal basin at Worsley.

Worsley Old Hall, now a restaurant, was lived in by John Gilbert, the agent to the 3rd Duke of Bridgewater. The Bridgewater Canal, often said to be the first true canal in Britain and the modern world, was built by the Duke in the 1760s to transport coal from his collieries in Worsley to Manchester. There are some 50 miles of underground canals.

In Worsley village we followed in the footsteps of the late Queen when we crossed a bridge over the canal and those of Queen Victoria when we climbed the steps up to St Mark's Church which was designed by George Gilbert Scott.



It is hoped to arrange visits in summer 2027 to some or all of:

Macclesfield Silk Museum, Gorton Monastery, Victoria Baths, Stockport Underbank and the Staircase House
Any other suggestions will however be most welcome.
